About Music Lessons:

These lessons are for beginners. They are meant to be a way for you or your child to explore music from different angles in a fun and creative way. It's meant to start off a healthy relationship with practicing, playing, and experimenting.

My hope is to create a safe, fun, and healthy space for children and adult beginners to find out what they enjoy, learn music basics, and build up from that base for future learning. This is why I am calling them Music Lessons, and not guitar lessons, piano lessons, etc. We may end up focusing on one thing more than others, but the idea is to try a lot of things in order to figure out what you or your child enjoys!

I have studied and practiced voice for 19 years and I am an intermediate piano, guitar, and accordion player. I am a lifelong student of music, and I am able to teach beginner piano, guitar, ukulele, accordion, and beginner and intermediate vocal training.

I have a keyboard, guitar, classical guitar, mandolin, accordion, and vocal recording equipment for students to use while they are here. If you have a different instrument in mind, please contact me to discuss.

Examples of learning topics:

- Music basics: notes, keys, tones, rhythm, pitch, scale, melody
- Guitar/Ukulele/Mandolin basics: notes, chords (finger placement), strumming, and reading music
- Piano basics: notes, chords, finger placement, reading music
- Vocal basics: breathing exercises, pitch, tone, key signatures

Basically, we'll start from the beginning and see where the student wants to go from there! I am always here to suggest next steps and encourage learning, but first and foremost I am here to support what the student is interested in and to have a lot of fun with it!

My name is Carrie Robinson. I am 32 years old and I have a cat named Philip. I love plants, music, and the great outdoors! I have been a singer/songwriter for as long as I can remember.

About My Space:

My space is located in Ramsay, Calgary, AB. There is free street parking directly to the South, next to the school. There is also a great park and a large green space there if you're looking to spend time there with another kiddo while waiting. There is also a Rosso Coffee down the street. (please note: you are not able to accompany your child into the lesson room, but you can wait in the backyard if you'd like).

I live in a basement suite with a walk up where the lessons will take place. When you arrive at the property for the first time, I'll give you a little tour! Please note the entrance is the **BACK DOOR**. This means you'll head down the staircase to the right of the house, OR you can come up the back alley and enter that way. I do have a cat, so if cat allergies are an issue, please let me know. He is very friendly and kid safe.

Please note: The first lesson (½ hour) is free as a way to ensure this is the right fit for you or your child. After that, lessons are \$28/half hour or \$56/hour. If you book a time slot (after your first lesson), you are agreeing to pay for that time regardless of if you show up or not. I am happy to try and reschedule if something comes up within 24 hours. I know life happens, simply contact me to see what we can do if you can't make it to a lesson.

All materials, including personal instruments, lesson books, notebooks, and other materials are to be bought and paid for by the student (or guardian), and not the instructor.

For the first lesson, you don't need to bring anything, unless you'd like a notebook to write notes.
